Examination Circular-2025

- Applications for appearing in the Sabhā examinations are invited for
 - Ṛk (Śākala śākhā) - Mūlānta, Kramānta and Ghanānta Pāṭhas
 - Kṛṣṇa Yajur (Taitirīya śākhā)- Mūlānta, Kramānta and Ghanānta Pāṭhas
 - Śukla Yajur (Kaṇva and Mādhyandina śākhās)- Mūlānta, Kramānta and Ghanānta Pāṭhas
 - Sāma (Kauthuma, Jaiminiya and Rāṇāyaniya śākhās) - Pūrvabhāga and Uttarabhāga

- The application must be completed online only. All details must be furnished correctly. Last date of submission of application: 30/11/2024

- The exams shall be oral and the students have to recite from memory only. Referral to any book or apparatus is prohibited. No external assistance shall be allowed during examinations.
- The applicant's age should not exceed 30 as of June 30, 2025. Applicants can be
 - Students studying in Pāṭhasālās or individually under a teacher and have completed the syllabus
 - Students pursuing higher study in the same Pāṭhasālā or elsewhere and
 - Persons who are self-employed or working anywhere after the completion of the study.
- The admission to the examination will depend on their qualification as below

- Applicants who have secured high marks (say, more than 70%) in the online exams only will be called for the final examination. Those called for the final should appear for the examination in person on the date, place, and time mentioned in the call letter.
- Online exams will be held in January 2025 and the final Exams in person by March - April 2025

8. Final Exam pass mark: 60% and above

- Those who have passed only shall be eligible for a reward, certificate, and reimbursement of onward and return travel expenses for the exam venue and reward ceremony.



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10. Certificates by will be handed over by post or in person. Cash rewards by NEFT transfer only.
11. Appearing one more time for improvement of earlier performance is permitted within 30 years of age and not more than 3 years from the year of passing. Reimbursement of travel expenses and incremental reward will be given only if the performance is improved.

12. The following reward monies will be paid to the passed-out students based on the percentage of marks.

13. In recognition of the invaluable services of the teachers in preparing the students, the teacher shall be awarded 20% of the eligible reward for each of his successful students.

14. Travel expenses from the applicants' place to the exam venue/function venue will be reimbursed at second class fare equivalent in an ordinary train on the shortest route or at actuals whichever is less. Local conveyance by auto-rickshaw is allowed at actuals. The teacher accompanying the students shall be eligible for train fare in the third-class air-conditioned compartment.
15. All travel reimbursement shall be done through NEFT only within 15 days of the examination/function.
16. The Trust reserves its right to reject any application if found ineligible for any reason whatsoever whether expressed or not.
17. The exams and evaluation methods shall be strict and standardized. The marks awarded by the panel of examiners of the Trust shall be final and not disputable.
18. The students will be thoroughly examined using Samānā Pañkti Praśna by asking many questions that require recitation of the Pañcaśat/ Ṛk/ Mantra/ Sāma starting with the words mentioned by the examiners. In addition to the Samānā Pañkti Praśna, a few questions shall be as follows:
 - Saṁkhyā Praśna: Questions will be asked by mentioning only the number of Kāṇḍa/ Adhyāya/ Praśna/Anuvāka/ Pañcaśat/Ṛk/Mantra etc.
 - Uttarā Pañkti Praśna: Questions will require reciting the next Pañcaśat/ Ṛk/ Mantra of the one specified by the examiner.
 - Viśeṣa-Pañkti Praśna: Questions will require answering the Special/Repeat aspects of Mantras.
